*Hello there! Join me on a trail of discovery along Llandudno prom. I will be your guide and together we will collect some **STAR LETTERS**!*



Welcome...

to the Children's QR Discovery Trail along the finest seaside promenade in Wales!

As you explore the prom, look out for the

little plaques with QR codes and the green HistoryPoints logo, like the one in the picture below.

There are 8 children's QR discovery points, from the pier to the Hydro Hotel. You won't need to cross the road to find any of them. The activity is free of charge (other than any data download charges from your mobile provider).

At each location you can read some cool facts about the history of that place and collect a star letter to fill in on the map overleaf. There are other QR-code plaques along the prom, but only the 8 shown on the map are part of the children's trail.

Let Walter the Victorian Lifeguard be your guide!

You may need to ask a parent or guardian to help you with the instructions below.


1. To complete the trail you will need a smartphone or tablet.
2. If you don't already have a QR scanner, search for 'QR reader' in your app store and download one of the free apps available to read the codes.
3. Launch the app which will activate your camera.
4. Hold your camera over the **bottom code** (or right-hand code) on the plaque, as if you are going to take a photo of it.
5. It will give you the address of a web page, which you can download for information about where you are standing.
6. Click on 'For kids' (button in top right corner) to find the children's page.
7. When you've read the text, click at the bottom for the star letter to write in on the map overleaf
8. Don't click on 'Mission completed?' until you've collected all the letters!

The letters will be included in the information you find when you scan each QR code and select 'For kids'. Write down the letters here. Make sure you put the letter in the star beside the correct location!



When you've found every letter, click on 'Mission completed?' on the web page to learn something interesting about Llandudno and your star word.
